## DEAR FELLOW CITIZENS,

The year 2024 is slowly coming to an end, and it's time to take stock of our work as CSV in the municipality. Together with our coalition partner, we have implemented several projects this year, and many improvements are planned for the years to come.

For example, one of our top priorities is creating a „green lung in Lënster for everyone“. A landscaped walking path is planned to connect Park Flammant (near the town hall), through Park Borrigs (near the church), and the „Jong Mëtt“ area (central bus station), all the way to the „Laangwiss“ area. The different parks will be open to the public, accessible for young and old, and interconnected. Together with interested citizens, we aim to develop creative concepts focusing on biodiversity, sustainable mobility, child-friendly spaces, and creative landscape design. We also plan to develop similar green spaces in all our villages. These initiatives will create new opportunities for leisure activities or simply for spending quality time together.



In this edition, you'll also get to meet our dedicated commission members. Feel free to reach out to them if you have questions or ideas on how to improve the quality of life in our beautiful municipality.

## PLACES TO GATHER

- **The Borrigs Castle and Park**, classified as national monuments, will have their future usage determined through a citizen workshop (PHOTO 5).
- Completion and inauguration of the **new village center in Beidweiler**, a project initiated during the previous legislative period (PHOTO 6).
- Increasingly, villages in our municipality now have gathering spaces for local associations and residents. For villages still without such spaces, we are in the planning stages.

## SCHOOLS AND CHILDCARE

- Extension of the **Jean-Pierre Welter building** with **9 additional classrooms** on an additional new floor (PHOTO 7) – Completion is scheduled for the 2025 school year.
- Creation of **new premises for the crèche** by reconfiguration of rooms in the current Maison Relais of the Jean-Pierre Welter building in Junglinster (PHOTOS 8 & 9).



- **Construction of the new Maison Relais** in “Loupescht” in Junglinster to accommodate 384 children (PHOTO 10).
- Short-term provision of **two new classrooms** in Bourglinster (PHOTO 11).

### SENIORS

- New facilities for the **Club Aktiv Plus** “An der Loupescht” in the center of Junglinster (PHOTO 13).
- For greater home safety: the municipality will cover installation costs for **telealarm** systems from both existing providers (PHOTO 14).

### ROAD SAFETY

- Finalisation of the **30 km/h zone** in **Gonderange** (PHOTO 15) and in **Bourglinster** (PHOTO 16).
- Installation of a safe **pedestrian crossing** in Gonderange (PHOTO 17).
- Traffic-calming speed bumps in the entrance at the entry of various 30 km/h streets (PHOTO 18).

### NATURE, CLIMATE AND ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION

- One of our priorities lies in the area of nature, climate, and environmental protection. The CSV also holds this responsibility in the College of Alderman. As a municipality, we must set a good example:
- For all our **new constructions, we consistently focus on sustainability and circular economy** when it comes to materials. In terms of consumption and production, we exclusively rely on renewable energy. Our existing buildings are also gradually being adapted in this regard.
- **Subsidies for our citizens** in this area are periodically adjusted and expanded. For example, there is now a repair bonus for electric household appliances. Through initiatives like the „Energy Caravan,“ we reach out to our citizens to inform and raise awareness.
- **In our green spaces, we place great value on preserving biodiversity.** Our new parks, such as the Flammant Park (PHOTO 20), the park near Borrig’s Castle, and the park in Eisenborn, are made publicly accessible and professionally maintained.
- The project by Soler to set up several **windmills** in our municipality is currently being developed. Citizens from our municipality will also be able to participate financially in this initiative (PHOTO 21).

## OUTLOOK AND OTHER TOPICS

- Remodelling of the **Rue de la Gare in Junglinster** starting in 2025/2026 (PHOTO 22).
- Remodelling of the **main street in Junglinster (former N11)** beginning in 2027, featuring more greenery, traffic calming, and bike lanes on both sides (PHOTO 23).
- Creation of a **new town centre (Place de l'Indépendance)** in Junglinster, with work set to begin in 2025 (PHOTO 24).
- Construction of a **new music school and a nature-oriented crèche ("Naturcrèche")** on the "Op Fréinen" site (PHOTOS 25 & 26).
- Installation of 24/7 video surveillance on key construction sites to improve safety (PHOTO 27).
- To account for the future growth in the number of students with our school infrastructures, a **masterplan** up to 2052 has been developed for the areas of Junglinster and Gonderange.
- We are also making progress in the **digitalisation** and optimisation of our municipal services. This will help us further improve the service to citizens in the future and **simplify procedures**. This will be done without neglecting the analogue service





## YOUTH

- Collaboration with the “**Night Life Bus asbl**” now enables **young people to return home safely** (PHOTO 28).
- In line with the coalition agreement, our young people should be **rewarded for their achievements**. We will develop a concept for fair and equitable financial support.
- A **one-time subsidy for Interrail tickets** will be offered to support sustainable, international, and cultural education for the next generation.
- The **subsidy distribution key for local clubs** will continue to be adjusted as needed, with a focus on youth activities (PHOTO 29).
